Faithful and Prudent Stewards 5

23rd Sunday in
Ordinary Time

Series Recap: Faithful and Prudent Stewards Who Embrace a Life of Discipline with Humility

Jesus told us, "Do not be afraid little ones for you have inherited the Kingdom of God." As inheritors of such a great gift, we are called to be faithful and prudent stewards of this gift. We must open ourselves to the gift of faith and allow it to grow to full stature.

As we CONSIDER the price that was paid for our salvation, it should motivate us to be more dedicated and faithful stewards. One of the spiritual practices of dedicated stewards is a life of DISCIPLINE. Through a disciplined life of prayer, steeped in a spirit of humility, good works and the prudent use of our time, talent and treasure we prepare ourselves to enter through the NARROW GATE.

The Decisive Steward- Let your Yes mean Yes and your No mean No!

There is a clear message in our scriptures this weekend, MAKE A CHOICE! BE DECISIVE! Wisdom 9 calls us out that for mortals, our deliberations are timid and our plans are unsure. Why are we timid, why are our plans unsure. I recently learned a new term in my conversations with some of you... FOMO. Fear OF MISSING OUT. The tendency to always be engaged, waiting for the next best thing with a fear of missing out. Although this can create an exciting and action packed life, it can also keep us from making commitments to those things which will bring lasting and eternal joy. For when we say yes to something we have to say no to something else. In our Gospel Jesus is clear that being a disciple who is a good steward necessitates the power of YES and NO in order to make decisive and concrete commitments to follow after him. He wants our full attention, He wants to be our first commitment, He wants us to say YES to him and NO to the things that lead us away from authenticity. He is direct... As a good steward, let your YES mean YES and your NO mean no as you consider how you use your Time, Talent and Treasure this year.

Introduction to the Stewardship Renewal

Today is the first Sunday of our annual Stewardship Renewal. This is the time of year when we make written commitments to prayer, parish ministries, and offertory giving - or what we commonly call time, talent, and treasure. I want to underscore the importance of this time of Renewal—not just for our parish, but for each individual.

Why fill out a Commitment Card every year?

Some of our parishioners have asked why they need to fill out a Commitment Card every year. In response, I have a couple of illustrations. What if you told the IRS, "I filed my taxes last year, and they're pretty much the same this year. Why do it again?" Or even worse, what if you told your wife, I gave you an anniversary card last year, and I still love you. Why should I bother again this year?" The moral of the story - some things are so important that they need a formal expression each year.

What's happening in the next few weeks

- In the next week, you'll receive a stewardship packet in the mail. If you have not registered at St. Anne, please do so in order to fully participate in this spiritual exercise.
- September 10/11 a parishioner will share his "stewardship journey" with us during Mass
- September 17/18 is Commitment Sunday, when all families are asked to bring their completed Commitment Cards to Mass. These are part of our spiritual roadmaps for the next year.

Conclusion

As you know, stewardship is becoming a "way of life" in our parish. It's not a program or a fundraising effort. It's the way we invite and encourage each other to follow Jesus with our time, talent, and treasure. I thank you for answering the call and supporting our parish

Watch the mail for the stewardship packet
Read through the materials and talk them over as a family
Consider what the Lord is calling you to say YES to and NO to in this coming year as you make a decisive decision to commit your Time, Talent and Treasure as a steward of God's kingdom.

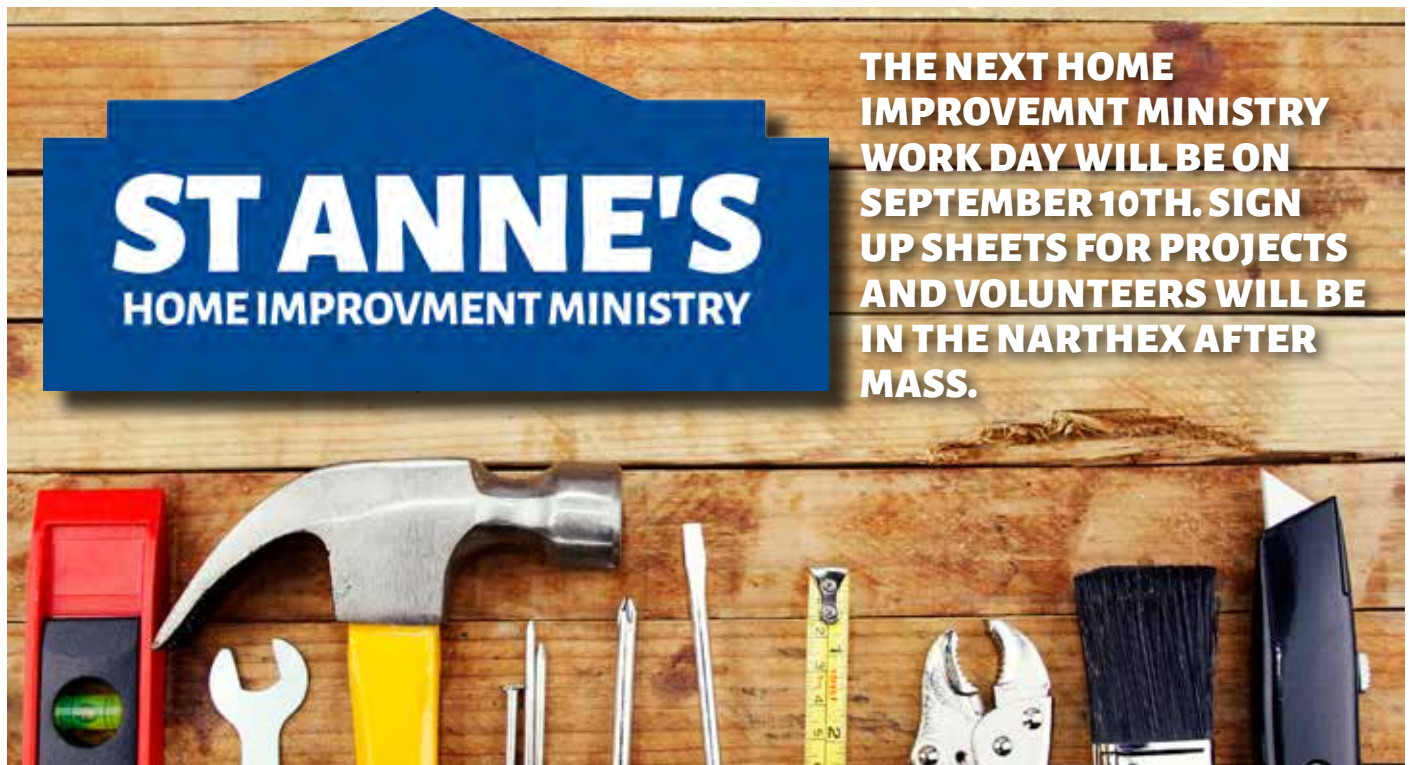
