Ordinary Time

Series Recap: Faithful and Prudent Stewards who are Humble and Decisive

Jesus told us, "Do not be afraid little ones for you have inherited the Kingdom of God." As inheritors of such a great gift, we are called to be faithful and prudent stewards of this gift. We must open ourselves to the gift of faith and allow it to grow to full stature.

As we CONSIDER the price that was paid for our salvation, it should motivate us to be more dedicated and faithful stewards. One of the spiritual practices of dedicated stewards is a life of DISCIPLINE. Through a disciplined life of prayer, steeped in a spirit of HUMILITY and the DECISIVE and consistent use of our TIME, TALENT and TREASURE we prepare ourselves to be DECISIVE in our choice to be disciples of Jesus.

Introduction to our Annual Stewardship Renewal

Today is the second Sunday of our annual Stewardship Renewal. This is the time of year when we make written commitments to prayer, parish ministries, and offertory giving - or what we commonly call time, talent, and treasure. I want to underscore the importance of this time of Renewal—not just for our parish, but for each individual. Now is the time to let our YES mean YES and our NO mean NO in what we know we need to do in order to strengthen our walk with Christ and His church.

Here are few phrases about stewardship, which I find helpful:

- Stewardship begins with an "attitude of gratitude." When we're thankful for the gifts in our lives, we're much more likely to want to share them with others.
- Stewardship is "living by giving." It's a lifestyle of generosity.
- Living stewardship is proof that "faith without works is dead." The good steward has a faith that is very much alive. As St. Paul says, "Whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God."

In the end, being a good steward is part of being a good disciple of Jesus. When we truly love God and put him first in our lives, then everything else follows. When we're in love with the Lord, we want to spend time with Him in prayer, we want to help our brothers and sisters in Christ, and we want to support God's family, the Church.

Stewardship is using our gifts for God's purposes instead of only our own. It's something we never "complete." It is a process, and God is always calling us forward.

What's happening in the next few weeks

- Ministry Fair- This Weekend in the Parish Hall after all Masses. Meet the ministry leaders, ask questions and enter the free raffles for three drones, a dinner for 8 at the rectory and a spa package. **Free raffle tickets will be given at the door.**

- September 17/18 is Commitment Sunday, when all families are asked to bring their completed Commitment Cards to Mass. These are part of our spiritual roadmaps for the next year.

Conclusion

As you know, stewardship is becoming a "way of life" in our parish. It's not a program or a fundraising effort. It's the way we invite and encourage each other to follow Jesus with our time, talent, and treasure. I thank you for answering the call and supporting our parish

Call to Conversion:

- Go to the ministry fair after mass
- Read through the materials and talk them over as a family
- Talk with your kids about Stewardship and help them use the Youth Commitment Card
- Consider what the Lord is calling you to say YES to and NO to in this coming year as you make a decisive decision to commit your Time, Talent and Treasure as a steward of God's kingdom.
- Fill out your commitment card and bring it to mass with you next weekend.

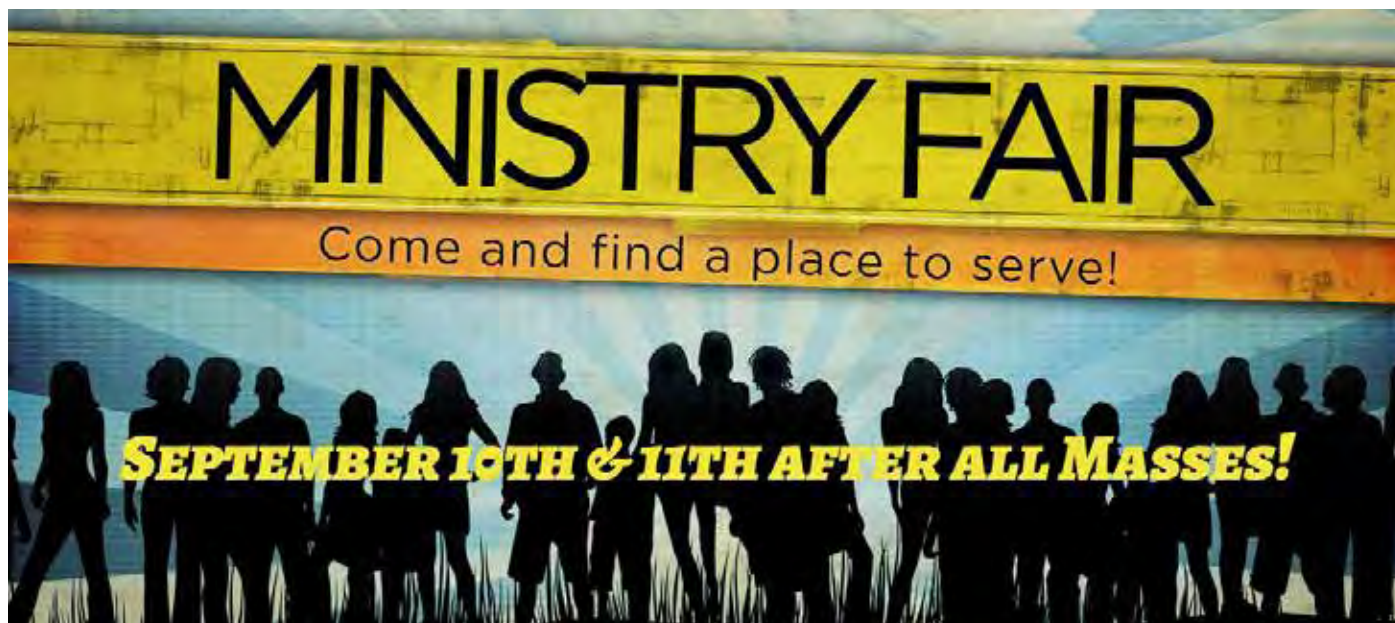
